Conditions of entry

1. Payment of Entry Fee constitutes acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. The Judges Decision is Final.
3. The show organisers promote good sportsmanship amongst all competitors, their families, grooms and spectators and any poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
4. The show organisers will not tolerate foul language to any persons on the show ground.
5. The organisers, officials and stewards must be respected. All are volunteers and their aims are to ensure a friendly competitive and safe event is achieved.
6. Neither the organisers and/or land owners can accept any liability for any loss or damage to any property or animals, including horses / ponies whatsoever.
7. It is asked that dogs are kept on leads and are not left in cars and that the summer heat is respected, in consideration of all animal's welfare.
8. All ridden horses must be 4 years old or over.
9. Any competitor/s who is seen to mistreat any animal will be asked to leave the show ground. Similarly if any horse or pony is seen to be lame or labouring under disease the competitor will be asked to leave the show ground.
10. The welfare of all horses and ponies is seen as paramount.
11. It is requested that hard hats of at least standard PAS015 or EN1348 are worn at all times while mounted.
12. It is recommended and requested that competitors hold third party insurance. Equestrianism can be considered a high risk sport and competitors choose to compete at entirely their own risk and should hold the relevant insurance to cover themselves and others and their property.
13. On occasions classes may clash, the organisers have constructed the schedule to avoid this where possible, however sometimes this cannot be avoided.
14. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes as appropriate.

15. The organisers reserve the right to make changes to the invited judges if necessary and unavoidable.

16. Objections must be made to the secretary in writing within 30minutes of the occurrence, along with a deposit of £30.00. This deposit will be returned if the objection is sustained.

We ask that you take any droppings and litter home with you as we want to leave the show ground as tidy as you find it.
